Human Resource Survey Results

In late spring 1999, <u>Community Literacy of Ontario</u> sent out a human resource survey to all Anglophone community literacy agencies in the province. CLO had received many requests for this type of information. Agencies were given a deadline of July 31, 1999 to respond.
